Each Intel SFI Starter Pack Activity has three components:



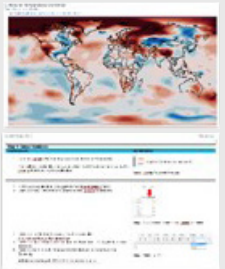
Educator's Guide
